



DEPARTURE FROM USA, COLOMBIA AND MEXICO ON 6 JULY 2011

1st. Day: Miami / Bogota / C. Mexico - Paris: Departure from the respective airport with Air France flight via Paris. Night on board.

2er. Day: Paris-London: Arrival at Charles de Gaulle airport and transfer to the new gate for your flight to Heathrow-London FA. Arrive and transfer to hotel London Hilton Olympia. We leave in the afternoon to meet the famous Harrods's store, one of the largest and most luxurious in the world, where we see life-size reproduction of Princess Diana. Rest of the afternoon to go shopping around Knightsbridge with the Chaperons. Dinner at Planet Hollywood and then walking through Piccadilly Circus, undoubtedly one of the liveliest areas of London. Hotel accommodation.

3rd. Day: London: Buffet breakfast. Sightseeing Oxford Street, Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square, Green Park, Westminster Abbey with the famous Big Ben, Ministries, Hyde Park, ending at Buckingham Palace to attend the famous Queen Changing of the Guards, all uniformed red with black hats, some on foot and horseback. Lunch. In the afternoon, visit the British Museum, a fascinating and comprehensive collection of Egypt (Pharaoh Tutankhamen). Dinner at Hard Rock Café and then a walk downtown with chaperones. Hotel accommodation.

4th. Day: London-Oxford-London-Windsor: Buffet breakfast, departure to the city of Oxford, famous for its ancient colleges, we will visit the Christ Church College and its dining room, where they filmed one of the Harry Potter movies. Lunch at Oxford and then departure to Windsor, royal residence during summer and a symbol of British royalty. After visiting the castle, back to London to the wax museum, Madame Tussauds, the oldest and most famous wax museum in the world. Here we can see replicas of the singers, actors and best-known athletes, like the Beatles, Brad Pitt, Michael Jordan, and the newest works on display; Penelope Cruz, Britney Spears, Elle McPherson, Naomi Campbell and Lady Di. The camera is a must; this will certainly be one of the highly remembered places. We will also be able to appreciate famous passages from the dark history of England. Dinner at Pizza on the Park. Hotel accommodation.

5th. Day: London-Paris-Bruges: Buffet breakfast. In the morning, departure to Folkston where we cross the Channel via Eurotunnel (The Shuttle), or via Ferry, where we land in Calais and on to Bruges in Belgium, to visit this beautiful walled medieval city, famous for its canals, bridges and lace. Lunch. Departure to Paris, the eternal city of lights, crossing the Paso Norte and arriving at the Isle of France. Arrival and hotel accommodation at Paris Eiffel Tower Hotel. Dinner. In the evening we will go walking around our hotel, La Opera, Fobourg, Sant'Honoré, Champs Elysees, to enjoy the shops and outdoor cafes. Walking, we will reach the Eiffel Tower where we will take all the pictures we want, with the tower lit in the background. Walk back to hotel and overnight at hotel.

6th. Day: Paris: Buffet breakfast. Sightseeing: Champs Elysees, Arc de Triomphe, Trocadero, Invalides, Latin Quarter, Notre Dame, Opera and Rue de Rivoli, Eiffel Tower, rising to 2nd floor. Lunch. In the afternoon visit the Louvre Museum to see masterpieces of painting and sculpture, including the famous Mona Lisa, Venus de Milo and Winged Victory. Back to the hotel, the bus will leave near Notre Dame so we can get in and cross it in stride. Rest of the afternoon free to stroll and shop, walking to the hotel. Dinner. In the evening, we will go to the famous Lido in Paris, to sip a glass of champagne while admiring the magnificent spectacle of choreography and dance. Hotel accommodation.

7th. Day: Paris: Buffet breakfast. Departure to visit the Palace of Versailles or the Sun King, the prototype of classical French architecture dating back to 1623, Louis XIII and Louis XIV. Lunch. In the evening we'll go to Mont-Martre, to visit the place of artists and bohemians, and the church of Sacre Coeur. Dinner in Mont Martre, the Auberge de la Bonne Franquette. After dinner, we stroll through the plaza to pose for a portrait or a funny cartoon, with one of the many local artists. Hotel accommodation.

8th. Day: Paris-Bordeaux: Buffet breakfast. Departure to the Loire Valley with its beautiful medieval castles admiring the Chambord Castle. Lunch at a typical inn Amboise, where we'll approach the house to see Leonardo da Vinci reproductions of inventions, (the genius of Florence). Arrival to Bordeaux, capital of Aquitaine, an important wine producer. Dinner and overnight at the Quality Suites Hotel.

9th. Day: Bordeaux-Madrid: Buffet breakfast. Departure to Madrid, via San Sebastian and Burgos. Lunch. Continue through the region of Castille, to the capital. Arrival and accommodation at the Hotel Melia Galgos. In the evening, tapas dinner in the neighborhood of Alonso Martinez, a very fashionable stop among young locals. Overnight at Hotel.

10th. Day: Madrid: Buffet Breakfast. City sightseeing tour, visiting the main sights of the Capital; Palacio Real, Plaza Mayor, Gran Via, Puerta del Sol, Calle Alcalá, la Castellana, Cibeles, the Paseo del Prado, and visit the Prado Museum, one of the most comprehensive art galleries in Europe. Visit the famous football stadium, Santiago Bernabeu, where the team plays Real Madrid. Lunch at a local restaurant for a delicious “Paella Madrilená”. Free afternoon to stroll or go shopping with the Chaperons. Dinner at Florida Park, a “Tablao Flamenco” located inside the Parque del Retiro, and enjoy the magnificent spectacle of song and dance, and then, after the show, we’ll all have chance to dance. Hotel accommodation.

11th. Day: Madrid-Zaragoza-Barcelona: Buffet Breakfast. Zaragoza exit via Alcalá de Henares, the birthplace of Cervantes. Visit the Basilica del Pilar. Lunch on the way and arrival to Barcelona in the afternoon. Accommodation and Dinner at the Hotel Catalonia Plaza. At night, walk through the Plaza of Spain (Montjuic), with its interplay of light and sources. Overnight at the Hotel.

12th. Day: Barcelona: Buffet breakfast. Visit overview of the City to admire the Paseo de Gracia, Plaza Catalunya, the Columbus Monument, the Cathedral, the Sagrada Familia and stop at the Guell Park. Visit the Nou Camp football stadium, where FC Barcelona (Barça) plays in the Spanish League. Lunch and walk through the Gothic Quarter and Las Ramblas. Rest of afternoon free to go shopping, or maybe back to the beach. Dinner and Overnight at the Hotel.

13th. Day: Barcelona-Nice: Buffet breakfast, Drive to the north, along the French Cote d’Azur, Cannes, Antibes and Nice. Lunch on the way. Arrival in Nice and accommodations at Hotel Massena. The rest of the evening will be to walk along this beach of the Costa Azul on the famous “Promenade des Anglais”.

14th. Day: Nice-Pisa-Florence: Buffet breakfast. Out very early, towards Monaco and Monte Carlo, with their Princess and Casino celebrity. Lunch. Continuing to the Italian Riviera, on the way to Genoa, to get to the city of Pisa. Visit the “Square of Miracles” and more of their landmarks: Leaning Tower, Cathedral and Baptistery. Arrival to Florence. Dinner and overnight at the Hotel Fenice Palace.

15th. Day: Florence: Buffet breakfast. City Tour: The Plaza of Honor, Palace of the Academy, the Cathedral of Santa Maria the Flowers, the Tower of Giotto, the Baptistery, and the Old Bridge. Visit the Academy of Fine Arts, where one can appreciate the original David by Michelangelo. Lunch. Free afternoon for shopping or searching interesting places with the chaperons. Dinner and Overnight at the Hotel. Great evening amusement in the “Space Electronic” (disco for youngsters).

16 th. Day: Florence, Assisi, Rome: Buffet breakfast. Departure for Rome, stopping in Assisi visiting the cathedral of San Francesco. Lunch on the way. Arrival to Rome and panoramic Tour of the City: Imperial Forum, the Coliseum, with a visit and tour of the interior, the Arch of Constantine, Piazza Venezia, Fontana di Trevi (take pictures and throw 3 coins in the water for the coming back to Rome, is another must). Dinner in a Roman “trattoria” with a delicious pizza. And if you are still hungry, enjoy a “nocciola” ice cream or a tiramisu while walking to Piazza Navona. Overnight at Hotel Palatino.

17vo. Day: Roma: Buffet breakfast. Visit the Vatican City (Museum and Galleries), visiting the Round Room, the Board of the Greek Cross, The tomb of Santa Elena and Santa Costanza, the Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo’s frescoes, and the Gallery of the Candelabra and Library. Visit the Basilica of San Pedro and admire the beautiful Pieta by Michelangelo. Lunch at the Colonnade, near the Vatican. Free afternoon walking or shopping on Via Condotti and Via del Corso, with the Chaperons. Dinner and Show in Trastevere, Rome’s bohemian area, enjoying Italian music. Accommodation at the hotel.

18th. Day Rome-Miami: Buffet breakfast. Departure to the Airport to take the flight to Paris and then, the flight that carried this Minieurop Group, to the destination end.

NEXT... European Party. Extension of Greece (only with 10 participants)

18th. Day: Rome-Venice: Buffet breakfast. Departure again through the Lazio and Tuscany countryside and enter the region of Emilia-Romagna. Lunch on the way. We will arrive to Venice and embark on the water taxi to the resort Gabrielli. Dinner at Hard Rock Cafe on the Plaza de San Marcos. In the evening we will enjoy a romantic gondola ride, and if we still have energy, we can walk to Harry’s Bar, an old bar frequented, at other times, by Hemingway, or drink a cappuccino in the Florian, (a famous cafe on the Plaza San Marcos), enjoying music and spectacular ambiance.

19th. Day: Venice-Verona-Innsbruck: Buffet breakfast. Visit on foot and by boat to this magical city: Piazza San Marco with its Basilica, the Ducal Palace, Riva degli Schiavoni, The Bridge of Sighs. Continuing to Verona and visit Juliet's balcony, unforgettable characters in the play of Shakespeare. Lunch. Proceed to Austria, arriving at Innsbruck at dusk. Dinner and overnight at Hotel Austria Trend Congress.

20vo. Day: Innsbruck-Munich: Breakfast. Brief Overview and walking tour of this interesting city, we will study Monuments Most Famous tales of Como, The Golden Roof, the Hofkirche, Imperial Palace, etc. Lunch. Towards the next Munich, famous for the "October Festival" (Beer Festival). Dinner and Overnight at the Holliday Inn Hotel.

21vo. Day: Munich, Zurich: Buffet breakfast. City Tour: the Palace Gardens of the Nymphs, the Olympic Village, The City Hall, Maximilian (the "Champs Elysees" Munich), then following to Lucerne, and Vaduz, capital of Principality of Liechtenstein. Lunch. Arrival in Zurich and the rest of the afternoon off. Dinner and overnight at the Hotel Park Inn (formerly Golden Arch).

22nd. Day: Zurich-Lucerne-Zurich: Buffet breakfast. Output for Lucerne and visit this historic medieval town with wooden bridge by Lake Lucerne. Ascent by cable car to the top of one of its peaks to admire the unique scenery of the Alpine mountains and enjoy a delicious fondue for lunch. Rest of afternoon free to stroll through Lucerne. Accommodation and dinner at the Hotel.

23vo. Day: Zurich-Paris-Athens: Buffet breakfast. Departure to Zurich Airport to take the Air France flight to Paris and then to Athens. Assistance and transfer to Hotel Zafolia. Sightseeing of the city: the itinerary begins with the Acropolis, which in Greek means "city on the summit". We will see the chairs of the Parthenon, almost as old as Athens, the Propylaea and the Erechtheion, visit the historic district and museum. Sightseeing tour of the modern city, the parliament with the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Hadrian's Arch, the Olympic Stadium and other city landmarks. Departure to the restaurant district of Plaka and the "Neos Rigas" to enjoy dinner accompanied by folk dances and traditional songs of Greece. Overnight at Hotel.

24vo Day: Athens-Piraeus-Myconos: Cruise AQUAMARINE (AEGEAN PEARL). " Buffet breakfast at the hotel. At 08:30 the group will be transferred to the port of Piraeus to board the cruise of 4 days and 3 nights of the Greek Islands, with the first destination Myconos. Free time to visit this beautiful island with its beaches, shops and chic cafes. We can also admire the medieval houses with Kastro (castle), overlooking the sea. The ship will depart from the island to follow the path towards Kusadasy. Lunch and dinner on board. Accommodation on the boat and sail to Kusadasy.

25vo Day: Kusadasy-Patmos: Full board. First port of Kusadasi, Turkey. Brief visit to the bazaars and excursion of the ancient Ephesus, where you can admire the masterpieces of ancient architecture, as the Magnesia Gate and the Library of Celsus before arriving at the amphitheater where St. Paul was arrested and expelled from the city. Transfer to Kusadasi port bound for Patmos. Arrival in Patmos with free time to visit this quiet island known for being the place where St. John the Evangelist wrote the Book of Revelation during his exile from Rome. Out of Patmos. Accommodation on the boat.

26vo Day: Crete and Santorini: Full board. Arriving on the island of Crete (Heraklion). Hiking to the Palace of Knossos, enjoying a short trip from the port city of Heraklion, guarded by the Venetian Lion, to Knossos, which was the prehistoric Minoan capital and thought to be the basis for the Maze, who was the legendary Minotaur. Departure from Crete to Santorini. Arrival in Santorini, one of the most beautiful Greek islands, rocky and steep, where we climb on a donkey to visit the Catholic and Orthodox cathedrals, then descend to the small port for a follicle, from where we have a magnificent view of the island. Dinner and overnight on board.

27vo. Day: Piraeus-Athens-Paris: Buffet breakfast on board. At 07:00 AM we arrive at the port of Piraeus. Departure for the airport for the flight to Paris. Farewell dinner. Overnight at the Astor St Honoré.

28th. Day: Paris-Miami, Bogota or C. Mexico: Buffet breakfast. Transfer to the airport for the flight that will take everyone back to their final destination.
